Although there are currently no restrictions in place, we still want to make sure that everyone who visits F-TEC take recommended precautions.

All employees, apprentices and visitors should follow these guidelines from the World Health Organisation on infection control, both whilst at work and in their daily lives:

- Frequently clean hands using alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water
- When coughing and sneezing, cover mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue, throwing this tissue away immediately and wash hands
- Avoid close contact with anyone who has a fever and cough

We are now living with COVID-19 as one of a number of respiratory infections. There are things you can do to stay well and protect others:

- Try to stay at home if you have symptoms
- If you have symptoms and do need to go out, wear a well-fitting face covering
- Get the vaccine if offered to give you the best possible protection
